ACE ACCEPTANCE CRITERIA

- Juniors/Seniors: Cumulative GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale.
- Sophomores: Cumulative GPA of 3.3 on a 4.0 scale.
- Students must maintain a 2.7 to continue participating in ACE courses.
- Satisfactory results from the SAT/PSAT or ACT/PLAN tests.
- A class rank in the upper half of the class.

ACE APPLICATION PROCESS

- Complete the online application at sf.edu/apply.
 - Be sure you select "ACE Student" as your student type.
- Submit an official high school transcript.
- Submit a letter of recommendation from a guidance counselor or teacher.
- Write an essay:
 - Tell us why you want to be an ACE student and specifically why you want to take your courses at USF.
- Homeschool students must also submit:
 - Personal reference (not from a family member).
 - List of extracurricular activities.
 - Bibliography of what you've read during high school.
