

ADMISSIONS PROCESS



COMPLETE THE APPLICATION:

1. Complete an application form at sf.edu/apply.
2. Submit official transcripts
 - a. High school transcripts
 - b. College transcripts (*if applicable*)
 - c. GED scores (*if applicable*)
3. Submit test scores
 - a. USF accepts both SAT and ACT scores.
 - b. Students transferring to the University may or may not need to submit test scores.



AFTER APPLICATION COMPLETION:

1. Submit additional program requirements
 - a. Review what programs have additional requirements at sf.edu/admissions.
2. If you are required to submit an essay, your admissions counselor will tell you. Please select from one of the following prompts for your essay. All healthcare programs, including nursing, radiologic technology, surgical technology, and physical therapist assistant applicants must use prompt two.
 - a. Describe how you have used or plan to use one or more of the Franciscan Values in your life. (*Our Franciscan Values emphasize: respect for each individual, joyful service, a trusting community, a deeper awareness of peace and justice issues, respect and care for creation.*)
 - b. Keeping in mind our Franciscan values, please describe why you want to attend USF, the reasons for choosing your major, what you know about the profession, and how you plan to be successful here at USF.
3. If you're a veteran, submit a copy of your DD214.



AFTER ACCEPTANCE:

1. Pay confirmation fee.
 - a. Deposits are fully refundable until May 1 for fall and December 1 for spring. This deposit will be applied to your tuition and saves you a seat in our next incoming class.
2. Sign up for New Student Orientation.
 - a. You can sign up for New Student Orientation after we receive your confirmation deposit.
